

Northern California/Northern Nevada EXPRESSIVE ARTS FESTIVAL GUIDELINES

I PURPOSE

The Expressive Arts Festival is designed to encourage youth in the development and use of talents and gifts which the Lord has given them for use in ministry.

II FESTIVAL GUIDELINES

1. This category includes presentations that express biblical truth without the use of speech. Examples include mime, sign language, chalk art and wordless drama set to music.
2. Each presentation must be five to seven minutes long. Presentations exceeding time limits will be stopped.
3. The subject of each presentation should be salvation/evangelism or Christian living.
4. Expressive arts presentations may be appropriate for any age.
5. Participants must provide judges with **three clearly typed outlines or music** describing the content of the presentation.

III JUDGING

Judging will be based on the following criteria:

1. The extent to which the outline or music is followed
2. Communication and clarity of message
3. Presentation (enthusiasm, body language, gestures, eye contact)
4. Overall flow of message (follows topic)
5. Ministry effectiveness of presentation
6. Movements (exactness and timing)
