

# AWANA GAMES Policies



## REGISTRATION OF TEAMS

Teams are composed as follows:

- **Sparks--10 to 17 players**—must have at least 3 boys and 3 girls who have completed 10 sections this year.
- **CO-ED T&T—10 to 14 players, 5-7 boys & 5-7 girls**—must have completed 10 sections this club year.
- **Trek—10 to 14 players**—5-7 guys & gals, must have completed Trek Check or 10 Guidepost sections this club year.
- **Journey 24-7—10 to 14 players**—5-7 guys & gals, must have completed current year's "Faith's Foundations" (#1).

There are age requirements, which may affect some of your players. **Coaches are required to attend training for each team registered.** Complete 2012 rulebooks will be available on the website: [www.awanacanv.org](http://www.awanacanv.org) after January 31, 2012.

Registrations for the AwanaGames will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. *Teams will be officially notified of their acceptance after the registration deadline.* Churches will be grouped together according to size and ability, determined by previous performance. All new churches will generally compete together.

Registration cost is \$95.00 per team. **Registration is not complete without staff recommendations. If you do not include names of staff members, your registration form will be returned.**

## AWANA GAMES STAFFING

Each church will be asked to **provide two staff people for each team registered.** Please help us out by placing **qualified** people in each position. Final staff assignments will be sent back to the Commander with AwanaGames registration confirmations. **All staff must wear their Awana polo shirts the day of the event.** Staff is not required to pay an admission fee and will receive an AwanaGames staff pin for their service.

## TICKETS

Each coach attending coaches' training will receive one pad of 25 tickets. The churches will keep all monies taken in from advance ticket sales in order to help pay for their registration costs. Therefore, it is possible for each team (if two coaches attend), to sell all their tickets and recoup most of their registration fees. This is not meant to be a fund raising event. There will be tickets available at the ticket booth on the day of AwanaGames at a higher cost for any adult who does not have a ticket. **All youth, high school and below, are FREE as well as all staff.** If you do not sell your tickets, please be sure to give the tickets to parents. AwanaGames is meant to be an outreach event!
